The guide we have used before (and 6 more other groups we recommended) is as follows:

Kundate (pronounced 'Kun-date')

He will do an itinery for you which will include Angkor Wat and Tonle Sap plus other places within the Angkor area. He usually charges around USD60-65 per day for a van because there is 8 of you. This would include him as a guide, a van, a driver and fuel if you are travelling within the Angkor area, which includes Angkor Wat, Ta Phrom, Preahkhan, Bayon, Angkor Thom, Pre Rup, East Mebon, to name a few. With 5 days and 4 nights, the Angkor area and Tonle Sap (plus shopping) would be enough, perhaps with an added trip further out to one or two other sights. If you go out of the Angkor area (e.g. Banteay Srei - best carvings) or want to watch the sunrise early at Angkor Wat (don't bother with the sunrise actually), there is usually an small extra charge.

I suggest that you start your tour the first day you arrive. In this way, he may include the airport transfer as well. you will need him for 4 days plus airport transfer on the 5th day (morning). Divided by 8 people, it is not a big sum. However, you will have to the Angkor pass is USD40 per person (for 3 days) and an extra USD 12 per person (If I recall) for the Tonle Sap boat ride. He will take you to buy the Angkor pass on the first day. As for tips at the end, it depends on you.

Mail me if you need further help or have questions to ask. I will also e-mail him to say that you will be contacting him. Mention that he has been recommended by Chan from Malaysia and he will know who I am.
